

## **Greenhouse Team Member – Experienced, Seasonal Position**

Members of our Greenhouse Team are responsible for growing and cultivating thousands of the plants that we are proud to sell each year. The main focus of this team is to produce top quality plant products that will thrive in our customer's home gardens, and to work with fellow staff to ensure that team and customer needs are met. Greenhouse operations are dynamic, fast-paced, colorful (of course!) and incredibly rewarding too!

In order to be considered for this position, you must:

- Have broad plant identification knowledge, from perennials to annuals, vegetables to small fruits, shrubs to groundcovers and more!
- Have experience in transplanting, propagating, watering, fertilizing and monitoring plant health, factoring in temperature, humidity and light variables, in a professional environment for a minimum of two years
- Have a current BC Pesticide Applicators Certificate
- Have knowledge of common pests and diseases that affect different plant species in a greenhouse environment, as well as hands-on experience in taking the related prevention and solution steps
- Be able to perform repetitive physical tasks and activities such as moving carts, loading and unloading plant flats, lifting and moving merchandise, watering etc. Moving up to 30 pounds is a common occurrence; 50 pounds occasionally. Frequent bending, and moving from ground level to table height, as well as higher reaching (to reach hanging baskets) are a requirement of this role.
- Be able to work one full day of the weekend (Saturday or Sunday)
- Enjoy working in a variety of environmental conditions from greenhouse to outdoor work. There will be hot days, there will be cold days, there will be wet days, there will be dry days, there will be snow days... sometimes all in the same day!
- Be organized, efficient and have great attention to detail, and be willing to learn more each day (and ask a lot of questions)!

Position Hours: During the main season, hours will be between 20-30 hours a week. Hours can be somewhat flexible to the candidate's availability but weekend work is required (as above). The seasonal end date is June 30, 2024

Wage: From \$20 per hour, commensurate with knowledge, skills and abilities
